- **Organization Overview:**
 - The Draft Network (TDN) is the most dynamic, progressive collection of football analysts and scouts ever assembled. Designed as the first company to ever provide extensive, year-round coverage of the NFL Draft, TDN hones into the diehard fan bases of the NFL and College Football to provide analysis through an NFL Draft and roster-building lens. - **Job Description/Responsibilities:**
 - The Draft Network offers two different opportunities one in scouting and one in media training.
 - Scouting Responsibilities: A scouting intern will attend scouting meetings, provide feedback on players that are assigned to him, and write up scouting reports or produce content around those players.
 - Content Responsibilities: A content intern will sit in on content meetings, pitch ideas for written, audio, or video content, and will work on projects given to them by TDN's managing editor.
- **Schedule Overview:**
 - Each intern will coordinate with their respective supervisor to set up a schedule for 20-30 hours of work.
