



As we continue to prioritize attendee health and safety, the following protocol has been designed to mitigate risk as you arrive in Los Angeles for the 2022 NFLPA Rookie Premiere.

Medical Support:

Dr. Thom Mayer, NFLPA Medical Director, will be available to provide support to players and their traveling parties. Should you have a medical emergency, please dial 911. However, for non-emergency consultations, please reach out to Dr. Mayer (703) 403-4147 or Sean Sansiveri (607) 426-0208, sean.sansiveri@nflpa.com.

Vaccination Status:

All staff and event partners/vendors/prospects that will be interacting with players and their guests must be fully vaccinated. Fully vaccinated means you have received two doses of the Pfizer-BioNTech or Moderna vaccine, or one dose of the Johnson & Johnson vaccine and it has been fourteen (14) days since your last shot. You are not required to have a booster dose.

Covid-19 Testing:

BioReference Labs will be onsite to conduct Covid-19 testing with the following cadence **for any staff and event partners/vendors/prospects that have direct interaction with players and their guests:**

- ENTRY - Participants ages 12 and up, regardless of vaccination status, will be subject to a Covid-19 test.
- SYMPTOMATIC ATTENDEES – Any attendee who reports symptoms consistent with Covid-19 should be isolated and tested immediately.
- VOLUNTARY – all attendees may volunteer for additional testing.

BioReference will conduct swabbing in the Roosevelt meeting room (7th floor) during the following hours:

Tuesday, May 17 th :	8 AM – 12 PM and 1 PM – 6 PM
Wednesday, May 18 th :	7 AM – 12 PM and 1 PM – 7 PM
Thursday, May 19 th :	6 AM – 12 PM and 1 PM – 5 PM
Friday, May 20 th :	6 AM – 12 PM

*****Closed daily from 12 PM – 1 PM*****

Beginning Wednesday, May 11th, you may sign up for your appointment(s) in advance by visiting: <https://appointments.bioreference.com/NFLPA>. Pick any time as the slots are just to get you into the system. **We strongly urge you to test the day/evening prior to when you will need to begin working. Test results can take an average of one (1) hour to receive. You will NOT be able to receive your credential to access the rotation spaces until you have a negative result.**

***** Any attendee who can provide documented evidence of a positive test result from an approved rt-PCR test (“Original Positive Test”) will be exempted from the normal virus testing cadence in this section for a period of ninety (90) days from the date of the Original Positive Test.**

Mask Requirements:

In accordance with state and local ordinances, mask wearing will remain optional (as of Monday, May 9th). However, local businesses maintain their own masking requirements. We strongly encourage the wearing of masks for partners and vendors interacting with players in confined spaces (e.g., content capture rooms).

Credentials:

Credentials may be acquired in the Royal room (6th floor) upon receipt of negative test results. Credentials may be picked up during Partner Registration during the following hours:

Wednesday, May 18 th :	7 AM – 12:30 PM and 1 PM – 8 PM
Thursday, May 19 th :	6 AM – 12:30 PM and 1 PM – 6 PM
Friday, May 20 th :	6 AM – 1 PM

Again, you will NOT be able to receive your credential to access the rotation spaces until you have a negative test result, so please plan your timing accordingly.

FAQs:

What if I’m only at the hotel for set up before players and their guests begin to arrive on Wednesday, May 18th?

You would not be required to test and instead are bound by your own employer’s policies.

What if I am only attending the evening events (Thursday, Friday and/or Saturday)?

Thursday (indoor): You may either choose to submit to a test or provide proof of a negative test within 48 hours of the event.

Friday (outdoor/open air): You will not be required to test or submit proof of a negative test.

Saturday (outdoor/open air): You will not be required to test or submit proof of a negative test.

What if my interaction with players is only outdoors at the photoshoot on Saturday, May 21st?

You will not be required to test.

What happens if my test comes back positive?

If you return a positive test, we will be unable to issue an event credential. If you test positive after receiving your credential, and in accordance with CDC guidelines, we recommend you remain isolated in quarantine for five (5) days after the confirmed positive test.
