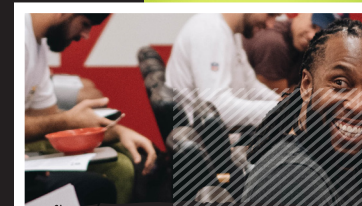

CONSISTENT COMMUNICATION WITH NFLPA

- Monthly call with Player Director
- Required attendance at Annual Rep Meeting
- Required attendance to all Rep Calls
- Assist with all NFLPA-related meetings on club property and in club city
- Facilitate communication between teammates and NFLPA

PROVIDE A VOICE FOR YOUR LOCKER ROOM

- Share player concerns with your Player Director
- Poll teammates regarding topics and concerns for the NFLPA to address
- Convey player needs, union cards, partner gift codes and fine appeals, to Player Directors
- Alert the Player Director to any special situations where individual players need NFLPA resources

PROVIDE A VOICE FOR THE NFLPA

- Educate teammates on the policies and initiatives of the NFLPA
- Appoint and coordinate a team council to strengthen union presence and assist with messaging
- Promote NFLPA programs and services
- Vow to keep all NFLPA matters confidential
- Stay aware of all pertinent information for players

PERFORMANCE OF NFLPA BUSINESS

- Assist with the collection of dues and GLAs
- Alert NFLPA about any potential CBA violations
- Connect teammates to the NFLPA regarding possible grievances
- Connect members with state workers comp attorneys
- Assist with getting players signed up to nflplayerbenefits.com
- Encourage teammates to maximize their benefits

EXPECTED, BUT NOT REQUIRED ADDITIONAL DUTIES:

- Attend at least one NFLPA event per term

 - b. Competition Committee Meeting at Combine NFLPA Collegiate Bowl
- Communicate importance of Financial Education Resources
 - a. Financial Finesse and
 - b. Registered Financial Advisors
